

Declaration on the Genetic Engineering Act

On 22 September 2003, the European Parliament adopted Regulations 1829/2003 and 1830/2003, which regulate the labelling and traceability of genetically modified food. In contrast to the old regulation, the labelling obligation is no longer triggered by the detection (PCR= polymerase chain reaction) of genetic modifications. In future, a foodstuff must be labelled if it is or consists of a genetically modified organism or has been produced from a genetically modified organism, regardless of whether this can be proven or not.

The products delivered by the ALFRU GmbH do not consist of

genetically modified organisms, nor
they contained genetically modified organisms.

Furthermore, there is no risk of contamination with genetically manipulated crops during production. Likewise, no genetic engineering processes or auxiliaries derived from genetically modified organisms (e.g. enzymes, fining agents, etc.) are used during production. Therefore, our products are not subject to labelling requirements, not even in the sense of the amendment of the directive 2001/18/EC.

The products sold by us comply in their entirety with the requirements of the German Food Law and are conventionally manufactured. Therefore our products are not subject to mandatory labelling

We undertake to inform you in writing if compliance with these requirements can no longer be guaranteed for a product.
